

# Search instructions

These instructions will provide you with directions to get the most out of your search. It is not necessary to type in every box to do a search.

## **TELL US WHO YOU ARE LOOKING FOR?**

Type in the name of the person you are looking for.

You can type in both the first- and surname or just type one of them.

Be aware that a Jewish name can have multiple spellings which the search engine cannot take into account. It may be necessary to try many different kinds of spellings.

## **WHAT YEAR IS THIS ABOUT?**

Here you see two boxes. Both have to be typed in for the search mechanism to work.

The box on the left, *Departure date*, you type in the date of departure.

The box on the right, *Arrival date*, you type in the date of arrival.

## **PORT OF DEPARTURE IN DENMARK**

Here you see a drop-down-menu with all the possible ports and places of departure. They were all found in the protocols.

Choose a port of departure, if you want to see who fled therefrom.

## **PORT OF ARRIVAL IN SWEDEN**

Here you see a drop-down-menu with all the possible ports and places of arrival. They were all found in the protocols.

Choose a port of arrival, if you want to see who fled thereto.

## **YEAR OF BIRTH**

Type in the year of birth of the person you are looking for.

## **WAS THERE ANY CHILDREN?**

Here you check off depending on whether you want to see search results with or without children. If you do not check either boxes you will get results with and without children.
